## There is a difference

**CAMPAIGN FINANCE** Individual contributions only. No PAC, no lobbyists, no party, no aggregators. A Clean Slate.

**CITIZENS UNITED** Neither unlimited funding nor corporate personhood can be allowed to stand. A constitutional amendment is entirely appropriate if needed and it has precedents.

**CLIMATE CHANGE** It's real, people cause it, and Congress must act. National security and societal survival are at stake. Atmospheric carbon must be reduced; curtailing emissions is NOT enough.

**TPP** It should be rejected. No international trade agreement is acceptable that does not protect the carbon control and sequestration programs of each member.

**FRACKING** The technology is old, but the application is new. We can not yet know the full impact and can not afford to destroy the rocks needed to sequester carbon.

**HEALTH CARE** Is a universal human right. Affordable Universal health care cannot be achieved through insurance companies. Changing ACA is not an attack on anyone's legacy.

**SUPER DELEGATES** A Congressional Super Delegate should initially vote as the District voted. It's a social contract between a District and its Representative.

**LGBTQ** We have made dramatic progress in the last three decades, but cannot lower our guard. There will be more push back.

**WOMEN'S RIGHTS** A woman's right to choose is absolute. Organizations like *Planned Parenthood* must be allowed to serve women. Equal pay for equal work is long over due. ALL are priorities.

**LOCAL ISSUES** District and State issues warrant support. *ColoradoCare* attempts to provide what Congress won't. Highway infrastructure should solve transportation problems, not bury them. Homelessness is not a crime and it must be addressed.

**LABOR** The systematic assault on individual and organized labor must be fought. Minimum wage should be at least \$15 an hour. Paid family leave is part of a civilized society. Overtime laws should be strengthened to reflect today's employment styles.

**VOTING RIGHTS** What we forged in the 60s is being eroded today in statute and courts. That erosion cannot be allowed to stand. Without the vote there can not be just society.
